

## *Dress Code*

Members, visitors, young people aged 13 and over and all others using the Club shall be suitably and properly dressed when within the Club premises. When attending Club Functions or during Henley Royal Regatta Week, the dress code will be as specified in the promotions.

Specific dress codes must be observed for the following areas of the Club:

<b>Dining Room:</b>	<b>Lunch:</b> Smart Casual (see below for interpretation) <b>Dinner:</b> Dress for gentlemen is deemed by the Club to be tailored sports jacket (with buttons) or blazer, and tie or with the option of a cravat. Ladies may wear smart trousers. Sportswear or jeans are not permitted at any time.
<b>Club Room:</b>	Smart Casual
<b>Bar and Lounge</b>	<b>After 7.30pm:</b> Smart Casual
<b>Sunday Lunch Ballroom &amp; Grandstand:</b>	Smart Casual
<b>Children and Young Persons:</b>	Members responsible for children and young persons on the premises should ensure that the above directions on smart casual dress are interpreted sensibly and with due consideration to members.
<b>Smart Casual Dress:</b>	Should be interpreted as a collared shirt, turtle or roll neck, and excludes all denim and sportswear including shorts, track suits and trainers and open toed sandals for gentlemen, or other overly casual clothes.
