## DESSERT WINE

**Sauternes, Château Delmond, 2016** | France | £25.00 | £5.40  
Clean juice is key to this modern Sauternes allowing for a minimal intervention approach in the winery. The challenging climate is mastered by Jean-Christophe who produces a delicious wine with notes of apricot, honey, citrus peel and orange blossom

**Familia Castaño, 'Dulce' Monastrell, Yecla, 2016** | Spain | £31.00 | £4.90  
This wine is deep purple in colour. It is fresh on the palate, with notes of plum jam and dried fig which are complemented by a clean acidity that balances the sweetness.

**Mullinex Family Straw Wine, 2018** | South Africa | £55.00  
Fabulously intense with marmalade, almond, marzipan, dried apricot and a hint of ginger. The grapes are dried outside until half raisined, concentrating flavours, acidity and sugar into a super intense, but balanced treat. The naturally high acid in Chenin Blanc provides great lift and focus. An incredible wine

# WHITE WINE

**Organic Macabeo, Castano, Yecla, 2020 | Spain | £19.90 | £6.75 | £4.95**  
Zippy, fresh organic white from a family-owned producer in sunny Southern Spain

**Pinot Grigio, Ca di Alte, Veneto, 2019 | Italy | £21.50 | £7.40 | £5.40**  
From high-altitude vineyards, this boasts breadcrumb and pear characters

**Sauvignon Blanc, Villa Montes, 2019 | Chile | £22.00 | £7.30 | £5.50**  
Bursting with ripe gooseberry notes and freshly cut herbs, crisp and dry

**Western Cape Fairtrade Chenin Blanc, Liberty Fairtrade, 2020 | South Africa | £25.00 | £8.40 | £6.30**  
Soft, rounded Chenin with notes of apricot and peach, making for easy drinking. Made according to Fairtrade ethics.

**Chardonnay, Monrouby, Languedoc, 2018 | France | £27.00 | £9.40 | £6.50**  
Ripe, rounded creamy Chardonnay with soft apricot and peach flavours

**Picpoul de Pinet, Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, 2019 | France | £28.00 | £9.55 | £6.70**  
Crisp, dry and refreshing, this is similar in style to a Muscadet and boasts fresh citrus notes.  
Great as an aperitif or with seafood and fish.

**Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Ribbonwood, 2019 | New Zealand | £29.50**  
From leading producer Framingham. Dry, with intense gooseberry and elderflower notes

**Vinho Verde Reserva, Quinta de Azevedo, 2019 | Portugal | £30.00**  
Vinho Verde is enjoying a well-deserved revival. Zippy and clean, lemon and lime zest

**Gavi di Gavi, Terre Antiche, Piemonte, 2020 | Italy | £32.00**  
Italy's answer to Chablis, this is a dry, full-flavoured white from the native Cortese grape

**Entre-Deux-Mers, Château de Fontenille Blanc, Bordeaux, 2019 | France | £36.00**  
A blend of Sauvignon and Semillon grapes make this enticing dry white from Bordeaux

**Riesling Trocken (Organic) Dreissigacker, Rheinhessen, 2017 | Germany | £39.00**  
Dry style, with crisp acidity, and hints of lime. Rounded, clean and refreshing.  
A good pairing for any spice, coriander or Asian influenced dish

**Chablis, Les Hauts de Milly, Burgundy, 2019 | France | £42.00**  
Produced from organic grapes on a small 12 ha plot, this family producer makes wonderful wines.  
Hints of gunflint and wet stone, with generous acidity and lively finish. A fabulous example of unoaked Chardonnay

**Pouilly-Fumé, Domaine de Bel Air, 2019 | France | £48.00**  
Crisp and steely, with citrus and pear hints and a core of minerality. Sauvignon Blanc  
from its homeland in the Loire Valley. Sublime with fish and seafood

**Chardonnay, 'Clay Shales', Crystallum, Hemel-en-Aarde, Hermanus, 2019 | South Africa | £59.00**  
Made by Peter Allen Finlayson, one of the top 'new wave' producers in South Africa. Classic flint on the nose  
with candied lemon, ripe peach and honeysuckle flavours on the palate, leading to a soft finish with hints of vanilla

**Pessac-Léognan Blanc, Chateau Lamothe Bouscaut, Bordeaux, 2018 | France | £63.00**  
Wonderful classic blend of 80% Sauvignon and 20% Semillon from an estate in Bordeaux  
which dates back to the 12th century. Honeyed, with grapefruit and pineapple and soft integrated oak.

**Chassagne-Montrachet, Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Borgeot, Burgundy, 2018 | France | £75.00**  
Rich, full-bodied white Burgundy made from old vines in the Côte de Beaune. Orange flower, tropical notes and  
balancing acidity with a thread of acidity for freshness. Rich and complex with soft buttery characters

**Condrieu, Maison Les Alexandrins, Northern Rhône, 2018 | France | £95.00**  
The producer is actually Nicolas Jaboulet, one of the most famous names in the Northern Rhone. Ethereal and complex,  
this rich dry white from the Viognier grape has hints of stone fruits and a minutes-long finish

**Meursault 'Sous La Velle', David Moret, Burgundy, 2017 | France | £130**  
Rich, full-flavoured, this classic is one of the finest expressions of Chardonnay in its homeland. Concentrated notes  
of citrus, bread and creamy vanilla, with a lift of balancing acidity. Just stunning

# RED WINE

**Merlot/Grenache, Les Vignes de Eglise, Southern 2019 | France | £19.90 | £6.75 | £4.95**  
Easy-drinking, juicy Merlot blend with good depth and bags of fruit

**Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah, Sanama Reserve, Andes, 2020 | Chile | £22.00 | £7.30 | £5.50**  
Full-flavoured, yet soft red packed with dark bramble fruits and a spicy finish

**Malbec Clasico, Kaiken, Mendoza, 2018 | Argentina | £26.50 | £8.90 | £6.50**  
From Mendoza, deep, rich Malbec with notes of chocolate and dark fruits, good structure

**Rioja Crianza, El Coto, Rioja, 2017 | Spain | £29.00 | £9.90 | £7.40**  
From a leading producer, this boasts creamy strawberry fruit with soft oak on the finish

**Château de Fontenille Rouge, Entre-Deux-Mers, Bordeaux, 2018 | France | £29.50 | £9.95 | £7.50**  
Our Club Claret. Highly recommended Merlot/Cabernet blend from a family producer

**Shiraz/Viognier, Willunga 100, McLaren Vale, 2018 | Australia | £33.00**  
Dark, brooding peppery Shiraz with a lifted dollop of white Viognier. Great steak wine

**Fleurie, Dominique Morel, Beaujolais, 2018 | France | £35.00**  
Lighter bodied French classic bursting with juicy summer fruits and a lengthy finish

**Paarl Pinotage, Fairview, Coastal Region, 2018 | South Africa | £39.00**  
By Charles Back, from coastal vineyards, there are hints of raspberry jam, spice, chocolate - great with steaks and lamb

**Château Macquin, St-Georges-St-Emilion, Bordeaux 2018 | France | £45.00**  
Right-bank, Merlot dominant Claret, ripe red fruit and fine-grained tannins

**Pinot Noir, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, 2017 | New Zealand | £49.00**  
Made by award-winning winemaker Matt Thomson. Light to medium bodied with summer fruits. Rich and velvety mouthfeel with great balance

**Chianti Classico, Isole e Olena, Tuscany 2017 | Italy | £53.00**  
From the producer of Super Tuscan 'Cepparello'. Medium-bodied, black cherries, complex

**Henry's Seven, Shiraz/Grenache, Henschke, Barossa, 2017 | Australia | £59.00**  
Henschke are one of Australia's leading producers, founded in 1868. This full-bodied blend offers a mouthful of rich dark bramble fruits, cracked black pepper and floral notes, leading to a spicy finish

**Barolo Le Albe, Vajra, Piemonte 2017 | Italy | £64.00**  
A beautifully balanced Barolo, 'Le Albe' has an elegant rose petal perfume, rich berry fruits. Dark, voluptuous and intense. Fabulous! From an estate practising organic techniques

**Château Capbern, Saint-Estèphe, Bordeaux, 2013 | France | £68.00**  
Sister property of Chateau Calon-Segur. Cassis fruit with a touch of spicy oak. Full bodied and generous with some lovely tannins. Sublime with a steak or slow cooked dishes

**Gevrey-Chambertin Domaine Taupenot-Merme 2014 | France | £79.00**  
Spicy, earthy red fruit and integrated charred oak. Silky and with lovely length, good tannin structure and will complement any game or strong meaty dish.

**Château Arnauld, Haut-Médoc, Bordeaux, 2014, France | £79.00**  
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petit Verdot. The 2014 has classic aromas of blackcurrant and cedar with smokey undertones, the palate is well-structured with intense notes of blackberry and plum and held together by taut tannins.

**Château Fleur Cardinale, Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, 2010 | France | £89.00**  
Full bodied, impressively built, with good acidity and light tannin. Packed with blueberry, blackberry and raspberry fruit intermixed with some cedar, vanilla and touch of spring flowers.

**Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Allegrini, Veneto 2015 | Italy | £95.00**  
Italian Classic from dried grapes made by one of the top names in Italian winemaking. Dense Morello cherry, intense rich palate with fine structure and good tannins. Perfect to carry over to a cheeseboard

**Corton-Bressandes Grand Cru, Domaine Tolleot-Beaut, Burgundy 2017 | France | £145**  
Superb classic Burgundy from top producers Tolleot-Beaut. Layered and complex with summer fruits and herbal notes all balanced by good structure, rich yet still soft.
